A New Year of Grace ~ Advent, 2019

Advent's like the first breath taken after you've been under water too long. Advent is the first breath of the Church Year. It's our season of Beginning Again, of moving away from all the make-believing of the past year and starting fresh in faith, with courage and hope.

More than other years, doesn't your heart *yearn* for the new grace this Advent offers? Doesn't something deep inside you want to shed all the rife pessimism breeding an incessant negativity and, worst of all, a demonizing branding that divides and alienates our families and our fellow pilgrims of God's world?

"Longing for light, we wait in darkness" will be our Advent prelude each Sunday. Singing its lyrics is meant to raise awareness of the darkness we sit in individually, as a parish, as a Church, and as a nation. We've longed for this true light all our life long. Advent's our seasonal opportunity to step out of the darkness and walk as a Child of the Light.

Taking any first step is a tough task. It's even tougher amid current familial and national rifts. If spiritual "fires" or "floods" shake you, your consoling grace is this: in the Light, all our warts, worries, wounds and wishes are *revealed*, *held and upheld* in the heart of God, who sees your vulnerable porousness and enfolds you in protection and hope.

Advent is our Beginning Again, an opportune grace to stop pretending, and become who we say we are: Children of the Light.

We sing: Longing for light, we wait in darkness...

We pray: We wait in joyful hope for the daily comings of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
