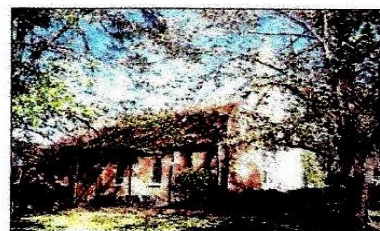

Routines...simple as a cup o' Joe to start the day...prepping breakfast and getting out the door on time for church or work. Routines are connected to expectations that help you navigate the day. It takes very little to disrupt your routines, e.g., driving behind a pine log truck, delays caused by road construction, or waking up sick.

After Christ's initial post-Resurrection visits, the disciples returned to their routines. The Fishers were back at the beach doing what they'd done daily before Their Call. Without their labors, their families would suffer neglect, go hungry, or lose their way. Their loved ones, their flock, needed to be cared for, fed, and guided.

The Risen One requires you do the same: care for, feed, and guide the "flocks" entrusted to you. Love is more than words that evaporate once they are spoken. Love needs to be shown in tangible ways. Today, Jesus asks you three times, "Do you love me?" *Nourish* others by *your presence*. *Care for your dear neighbors*. *Guide by your example* more than by your words. Watch "what you do to see what you believe." ~Helen Prejean, CSJ

Whatever your routine, what's important is your loving presence where you are. Being present is shown in the ways you care for, nourish, and guide. *Disciples' routines* are steeped in the grace of servant-leadership.

"...when you were younger, you used to dress yourself and go where you wanted, but when you grow older, you will stretch out your hands...someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go."

Christ's question, "Do you love me?", is not a routine one. Care for, nourish, guide in Jesus' Name.
