1st Sunday of Lent February 21, 2021

Morning, Church!

Desert. Deserted. Wilderness. Wildness. Untamed. Parched. Barren. This is no playful sandbox.

Not many Christians are anxious to enter into this Lenten Season of spiritual desert aridity, mostly since the past year seems like an elongated Lent.

Saturday, we SSJs reflected on Jesus' desert time. Here is some of our reflections and faithsharing.

Jesus didn't go into the desert alone. The Spirit lead him into the desert and Jesus allowed himself to be lead.

How attentive are you to the lead of the Spirit? How is the Spirit leading you this Lent?

What unnerves you as you enter a spiritual desert? The Biblical setting of the desert is a parallel to the COVID desert's sameness and isolation.

The Spirit is leading you into the desert. If you enter into these 40 days wholeheartedly, you will feel the same aloneness Jesus did. You may experience the same dryness of the heart,

You'll must be hyper-vigilant in the spiritual desert, attentive to the Spirit's promptings.

Mostly, guard your heart against temptations that stealthily infiltrate into your thoughts, feelings, and actions. They are subtle, unlike Jesus' confrontation with evil's lure to power, praise or possession.

Temptations test your heart and cause you to:

- ~ doubt the Spirit's lead
- ~ doubt Jesus is with you
- ~ doubt that anything new can happening in your heart in this wilderness
- ~ doubt that Lent is your time to surrender all that you are as Jesus did
- ~ doubt that there is deeper reason why the Spirit lead you here and will stay with you - no matter what.

Your 2021 Lenten journey is a once-in-a-lifetime grace. Don' get ahead of, or miss the grace.
