Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time September 15, 2019 Lost has many images. Being lost or losing can be layered with bewilderment and anxiety. You can lose a thing, or your child in the mall, your car keys or your wallet. You can be lost in grief, illness, unemployment, or feel lost by your child's defiance or disappointments. You choose to be lost, by staying away from family, church, or your community. You will get lost if you have no inner compass of conscience to guide you. All experiences of lost have levels of anxiety attached to them. If you're lost spiritually, that's a whole other kind of being lost!

Today's Word shows various ways you can be lost and how the Divine Seeker finds you. The Hebrews were lost when they wandered back into idolatry. Being faithful to God and their Covenant seemed too hard to them. They lost themselves by returning to their former ways of living. They could control graven idols who had no expectations of them. The Divine Seeker had expectations and couldn't be controlled. Despite their blasphemous choices, God gave them another chance. *That's the way God is.* 

The triplet of parables reveals the relentlessness love of the Divine Seeker, one who understands our senseless choices. No single sheep, no single coin, no single person stays lost. The Divine Seeker gracefully navigates all the barriers of excuses that keep you lost and offers you ways to be found, to return home to a stunning celebration of welcoming mercy. *That's the way God is.* 

Look long and hard enough and you will draw parallels in your own life from today's Word. Remember times when you were "stiff-necked" like the Hebrews and chose to worship strange gods. Remember when you were so lost that you were willing to sacrifice key relationships just to be right, like Paul. Remember when you were so lost in your own righteousness, that you were unappreciative and jealous of others' blessings and successes. *Remember that's not the way God is*.

The Divine Seeker knows your heart and all the ways you get lost. The Divine Seeker's grace "has been abundant, along with the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus." (1Tim. 1:14) Remember that the next time you feel lost *the way God is*.


