# Morning, Church!

Receptivity, the art of receiving, being open to and accepting of others is a much-needed grace today. Being welcomed, accepted, and listened to are hallmarks of the virtue of hospitality. In your months of staying home, you had hundreds of opportunities to be receptive, open, and accepting of your family members.

In the Book of Kings, the Shunammite woman, a person of influence, is an image of receptivity, acceptance, and openness. She knew travelers moved in a dangerous world and depended on the hospitality of strangers. For the traveler, finding a safe place to stay proved to be challenging. Not only did she opened her home to Elisha, she gave him his own furnished room! Moved by her receptivity, Elisha expresses his gratitude by favoring her with two miracles, the birth of a son and his resuscitation following his mysterious death. Then he counseled her to avoid the impending famine by moving to Philistia for seven years where her family would be safe.

Receptivity, welcoming others the way you want to be welcomed, is a visible grace, and a costly one, too. It cost your ego to graciously receive another, especially a stranger; or one who is different from you in any way, by not judging them as less than because they're different from you. Naturally, the human ego is highly resistant to this grace. To receive someone with openness and acceptance is to receive Christ.

"Whoever receives you receives me."

To emphasize this grace of gracious receptivity, Jesus says it six times in today's gospel. He says be receptive to the prophets of God in your midst, those who speak in God's Name and call you to wholeness and holiness. Be receptive to the witness of those who live a virtuous and honorable life and, by doing so, call you to do the same.

Nowadays is no different from Biblical times. The prophets, virtuous, and honorable ones are gifts from God. Their presence serves as an invitation to you to open your hearts and receive them, as they are, and to listen to them with an accepting heart. All of us are travelers, pilgrims making our way home to God. All of us are hoping to be welcomed, listened to and accepted, All of us hope that the people we encounter, especially the "stranger" will make room in their hearts for us.

Receptivity is an inside graciousness within you that you offer another person, so when they're around you, they feel "at home." As you start to move about more frequently, remember Jesus' words, "Whoever welcomes you, welcomes me." This is The Way to follow Jesus. This is Divine receptivity. This is The Way home.


