Morning, Church!

Mark's gospel account begins without Matthew's genealogy or Luke's poetic infancy narrative. It begins by proclaiming the reign of God is now! Mark leaps from the River Jordan right to Jesus' first recorded miracle. It's a bold beginning in a most dramatic scene which demonstrates Christ's power and authority over ever aspect of Creation ~ evil spirits included.

Initially captivated by Jesus' teaching in Capernaum's synagogue, Christ's onlookers were deeply spellbound by the magnetism and authority of his words. He spoke with authority and used his authority for service.

"...he taught hem as one having authority and not as the scribes."

Ironically, the *evil spirit* is the first to recognize Jesus. It becomes downright threatened by Pure Presence, Grace, and Truth. His light shown on their darkness and through them into a panic. The evil spirit recognized Jesus in the crowd and knew he could destroy him. So very powerful is Christ's presence that he evoked a public, profession of faith from this demon of darkness.

"I know who you are ~ the Holy One of God!"

Jesus the rabbi-teacher then reveals another aspect of his ministry: power over Creation through healing. Jesus came to restore Creation to its Original Grace. To heal the demoniac, Jesus is impelled to confront the unclean, spirit who has just acknowledged his divinity. He is compelled to call out the evil spirit possessing the demoniac and use this encounter to show ~ by his words *and* actions ~ who he is:

The Holy One of God!

Those who witnessed this miraculous moment on the Sabbath, were astonished by Jesus' power in what they saw and heard. What Jesus said, how he said it and how he acted were different from anything they had ever seen. This were are challenged by Jesus to speak and act as he did. Those who witnessed this miracle, including the First Followers, failed to recognized the Son of God, and the evil spirit did!

Today, Jesus challenges all of us to identify and call out the evil spirits and their darkness, and to cast them out in Jesus' Name. Name the dark spirits that possess our nation, our Church, and your hearts. Name and uncover them and bring them into the Light, so we can be healed and restored.

The darkness, the evil spirit can no longer have any room in your hearts, your thoughts, or your actions. Pray for the grace to divest yourself of the demonic attitudes, any spirit of darkness that possesses space in your life and closes you off from Christ's abundant, healing grace. Name who or what holds your heart hostage, or steeps you in the dark addictiveness of pride closes your heart off from the yet-to-be-discovered grace and truth revealed in Christ and in those around you.
